Hazardous Chemical Communication Program

Maine School Administrative District #33 recognizes the potential danger that exists for its employees, students, and visitors in their use of and exposure to certain chemicals associated with their work. In concert with the District's commitment to maintain a healthy and safe environment, the following plans, developed by Chemsafe Chemicals, Inc., shall serve as the *District's Hazard Communication Program*:

- **Hazard Communication Plan**
This plan is designed to minimize exposure to chemicals and is applicable to all District "service oriented" (custodians, cooks, etc.) employees who work with chemicals.
- **Chemical Hygiene Plan**
This plan is designed to minimize exposure to chemicals, without compromising student laboratory experiences, and is applicable to all laboratory operations and employees.
- **Universal Waste Management Plan**
This plan is designed to manage non-hazardous, hazardous, and universal wastes in a cost-effective manner through a combination of manufacturer take-back programs, recycling, and controlled purchase procedures.

These plans have been designed to meet both the letter and spirit of the applicable *Standards* and may be viewed at each school's administrative office.
